Step 1: Log in to the site (Registration tab).

SUBMISSION OF REPORT MATERIALS

Step 1: Prepare the materials for the report in compliance with the formatting guidelines.

Step 2: Log in to the site and follow the “**Submit New Report**” link.

Step 3: Complete the form and upload the report file.

The author may correct the data of the report and/or re-upload the file, if necessary (you will need to re-authorize on the site to make the appropriate amendments). All amendments and additions should be completed **no later than June 1, 2020**.

Languages of reports: Russian and/or English.

Report materials which are incorrectly formatted or not uploaded to the site **WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED** for publication. The Organising Committee shall reserve the right to select or reject submitted materials.

REPORT FORMATTING GUIDELINES

Report Formatting Guidelines: Microsoft Word. Colour illustrations are allowed. Illustrations in TIFF or JPEG format (resolution of at least 300 dpi) and the report file should be archived into a single ZIP file which shall be uploaded to the site. The file name should be the speaker's last name in Latin letters (without spaces, punctuation or Cyrillic letters).

Report volume (except commissioned) — no more than two A4 pages (2.5 cm margins on all sides, single spacing, Times New Roman font, 12 pt).

1. Report name in capital letters, centred.
2. Empty line.
3. Authors (in bold), centred, email for contacts should be given in parentheses after the last name.
4. RMS branch and organization, centred.
5. Empty line.
6. Report name in English in capital letters, centred.
7. Empty line.
8. Information about the authors in English.
9. RMS branch and organization in English.
10. Empty line.
11. Abstract text, width alignment, hyphenation is not allowed. The first line of the paragraph — indent of 1.25 cm. Acknowledgments and references to funding should be given in italics as a last paragraph.
References to literary sources should be given as follows: (Ivanov, 1817).
12. Empty line.
13. References (left alignment). References format:
